Write 2 characteristics about each California Indian group.

Shasta, Yurok, and Hupa – *lived in the forest *modified the environment to meet their needs *cut down trees to carve canoes *traveled rivers in search of food *used wood to make houses *fished for salmon

Modoc *lived among marches, rivers, and lakes *used plants as a food source, for medicine, clothing, and baskets *hunted antelope, deer, sheep, and birds

Washoe *hunted animals such as rabbits, antelope, and deer *depended on the plants that grew in the mountains *known for their beautiful baskets

Miwok and Yokuts *lived in the Central Valley *rich farmland *depended on gathering resources rather than farming *hunted deer, rabbit, and elk *picked acorns and fished for salmon

Pomo *depended on the ocean to survive. *ocean was a source of food for all coastal people *people caught fish and shellfish *trapped seals and sea lions and used their fur for clothing *fished for salmon

Gabrielino *settled in Los Angeles and Orange County because of the resources *hunted, fished in lakes and streams, and picked acorns *used tule, a long grass, to make their homes

Mohave and Yuma *Colorado River would flood every year and provide great soil for crops *they would plant corn, pumpkins, melons, and beans
