Vocab.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*<b>weir</b>- a dam</li><li>*<b>obsidian</b>- black glass-like material usually used to make tools</li><li>*<b>climate</b>- weather that a place has over a long period of time</li><li>*<b>obtain</b>- to acquire or get</li><li>*<b>structure</b>- a building</li></ul>
Obtaining Food	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*California Indian groups were not farmers</li><li>*hunted and gathered food</li><li>*some roasted pinecones and ate the seeds and some made soup or bread</li></ul>
Traps and Tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*finding food was not always easy</li><li>*had to develop ways to hunt, trap, trade, or travel for food</li><li>*some would set traps to catch animals</li><li>*some would build weirs to catch salmon</li><li>*obsidian comes in many different colors</li><li>*obsidian is made from lava</li></ul>
Trading Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*if the Indian group did not have something, they would trade with another group</li><li>*Yurok would trade canoes, Chumash traded shells, and Pomo traded dried meat</li></ul>
Homes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*their homes were built based on the climate</li><li>*houses were usually built out of wood</li></ul>
Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*most came from animal skins or plants</li><li>*clothing depended on the climate</li><li>*certain things were worn on special occasions such as fancy hats</li></ul>
