Vocab.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">*weir- a dam*obsidian- black glass-like material usually used to make tools*climate- weather that a place has over a long period of time*obtain- to acquire or get*structure- a building
Obtaining Food	<ul style="list-style-type: none">*California Indian groups were not farmers*hunted and gathered food*some roasted pinecones and ate the seeds and some made soup or bread
Traps and Tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none">*finding food was not always easy*had to develop ways to hunt, trap, trade, or travel for food*some would set traps to catch animals*some would build weirs to catch salmon*obsidian comes in many different colors*obsidian is made from lava
Trading Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none">*if the Indian group did not have something, they would trade with another group*Yurok would trade canoes, Chumash traded shells, and Pomo traded dried meat
Homes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">*their homes were built based on the climate*houses were usually built out of wood
Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">*most came from animal skins or plants*clothing depended on the climate*certain things were worn on special occasions such as fancy hats
